Procedure for Placement in the City of St. Albert

Signs which **cannot** be placed on public and/or City owned property:

- New Listing
- House for Sale
- House for Rent

Signs which **can** be placed on public and/or City owned property:

- Open House
- Garage Sale

Open House and Garage Sale signs **cannot**:

- Be posted more than 24 hours prior to the event and cannot remain in place more than 24 hours after the event
- Interfere with, be confused with, detract from or be placed on a traffic control device, municipal sign, or other municipal device
- Be placed on a road or median
- Be placed with 5m of a fire hydrant or emergency use equipment
- Interfere with sight lines near roadways
- Interfere with movement of pedestrians and/or vehicles
- Be placed within 30.5m of any intersection

Signs may also be seized if they are in a state of disrepair, interfere with City Maintenance operations, or a safety or emergency situation requires. An Open House Sign may be placed on a Boulevard in a Residential District if the Open House Sign:

- is Self-Supported;
- does not exceed 0.6m in width;
- does not exceed 1m in height; and
- is posted no more than 24 hours prior to the advertised event and no more than 24 hours following the advertised event.

Penalty

Signs in contravention of these regulations may be seized under the Traffic Bylaw 18/2005 and owners may be charged the specified penalty of \$150 for each sign placed in contravention.
